PRIVACY STATEMENT AND THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS POLICY

This privacy statement provides details of what to expect when Black Cat Creative Limited collect your personal information in connection with our services and confirmation that we take responsibility for the protection of your personal data particularly seriously.

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into force on 25 May 2018 and is designed to unify data privacy requirements across the European Union and replaces the Data Protection Act 1998. There are several data protection principles and this statement details how personal data is obtained, stored, and processed as follows:

Data must be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to individuals; must be collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes;

must be adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed;

must be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date; every reasonable step must be taken to ensure that personal data that are inaccurate, having regard to the purposes for which they are processed, are erased, or rectified without delay;

must be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed;

must be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures.

What data will we hold involving you

We will only receive your personal data which is directly or indirectly connected to your order for our services. This will include data provided by telephone; digital communication; post; or via our website.

How will we utilise your data?

We will utilise your personal data to deliver the services you have ordered from us or best practice promotions and for no other purpose. This will include the provision of your data to our printing partners should you order print from us.

Our promise to you

Your data will only be utilised for the purposes outlined in this statement and will not be passed by us to any external parties for marketing or other sales related purposes.

How we store your data?

Your data will be held electronically within a secure web-based database.

How long will we keep your data for?

Your data will normally be retained for a period not exceeding 6 years to allow us to provide copies of files should you lose them. This includes certain elements of financial data which are legally required to be retained for a period of 6 years. Under the new GDPR regulations your non-regulatory data can only be kept for so long as you wish to allow it and you can request for it to be deleted at any time.

Your rights

Under the Data Protection Act 1998 and The General Data Protection Regulation you have rights as an individual which you can exercise in relation to the information we hold about you. You have a right to complain to the Information Commissioners Office if you consider that we have

breached our data obligations.

Our website
